

ORDER DENYING FURTHER REVIEW

The court has received and reviewed the defendant's motion/petition for emergency review filed pursuant to section (j) and (j)(12) of the April 14, 2020 Court of Appeals *Second Amended Administrative Order Expanding And Extending Statewide Judiciary Restricted Operations Due To The Covid-19 Emergency* (hereinafter "Order A").

Pursuant to section (j) of the above-identified order, the Administrative Judge or her designee has determined that the matter can be resolved without a hearing.

The court has carefully considered the content of the motion and the assertions/representations therein, any response to the motion, the court file, Maryland Rules 4-216, 4-216.1, 4-216.2, statutory requirements applicable to this individual case, as well as the April 14, 2020 Court of Appeals *Administrative Order Guiding The Response Of The Trial Courts Of Maryland To The COVID-19 Emergency As It Relates To Those Persons Who Are Incarcerated Or Imprisoned* (hereinafter "Order B").

In addition to the applicable statutory requirements, rules, and Administrative Orders, the court has further considered (as provided in the motion/petition) the specific requirements of Order B, sections (e), (f), and (g) pertaining to the defendant's unique health/personal circumstances and risk vis-à-vis COVID-19, and also the existence of conditions that may protect victims and the community at large from public safety risks should the defendant be released. The court has further considered the requirements of Order B, section(h) regarding the risk posed by COVID-19 to people confined.

Based upon careful and deliberate review of the above, the court finds that further consideration of the above-captioned matter is not presently warranted and further finds that after full and careful consideration, including the unique risks presented by COVID-19, that further consideration for change in the defendant's detention status is not presently warranted.
