SWORN STATEMENT NO.6 FROM PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY JAIL

We do not have cell phone footage of abuses inside prisons and jails. I am reading the following sworn testimony from a person held in the Prince George's County Jail to lift this veil of secrecy and hold our justice system accountable. This testimony was taken in April 2020.

When I first entered the Detention Center, I was placed in the Medical Unit. I have numerous medical issues, including neck and back issues, I walk with a cane, and I am currently having kidney issues, including blood in my urine. I was moved from the Medical Unit about halfway through my thirty-day incarceration, and I do not know why, but it may be because it was getting more crowded in the Medical Unit.

I am currently experiencing cold symptoms, such as coughing and sneezing. I try to stay in my cell as much as possible to avoid getting others sick. However, I do have a cellmate that I cannot stay away from.

Everyone is concerned about the Coronavirus. I am very worried and I am already sick now. I am just trying to stay away from people and isolate myself.
